NCECC (EDU 119) or equivalent and an AAS (or higher) degree in Early Childhood Education/Child Development (ECE/CD); or an AAS or higher degree in any area with 12 semester hours in ECE/CD and 1 year experience in a Licensed Early Childhood Education Facility.

Or

NCECC (EDU 119) and 9 semester hours in ECE/CD and enrolled in 3 semester hours in ECE/CD and 1 year of experience OR EEC level IV and 1 year of experience.
